This Week's Lesson:

Jesus Appears to Friends on The Road

Take Home Point:

Jesus is alive!

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- *Puppet:* Judy hid her identity from the children, just like Jesus hid his identity from his friends.
- *Bible:* We read a big book about Easter and acted out parts of when Jesus became alive.
- *Snack:* We ate a snack with a hidden middle.
- *Craft:* We painted a picture of Jesus that is hidden.
- *Game:* We played a game called "I Know Who You Are."
- *Singing:* To the tune of *Farmer in the Dell*: "Jesus is alive. Jesus is alive. He came to save us all. Jesus is alive."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Let your child see that you are reading from the Bible as you paraphrase down to a few simple sentences. Luke 24:13-35

LEARN BY DOING:

Show your child how you can hide your identity by dressing up or disguising each other. Explain that Jesus was hidden from his friends on the road, even though they could see him.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- Jesus died then became alive.
- Jesus is with us always, even if we can't see him.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult

Dear God,
We love you.
Thank you for Jesus.
He died for us.
Now he is alive!
Thank you, thank you, thank you.
In Jesus' name.
Amen.
