Mother's Day

Take Home Point:

I can help my mom.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- *Puppet:* Judy finds out that helping mommy is a present.
- *Bible:* Jesus helps his mother at a wedding.
- *Snack:* We changed white milk into red and ate wedding food.
- *Craft:* We "printed" a Mother's Day card.
- *Game:* We played the "Can I Help You Mom?" game.
- *Singing:* To the tune of *Mary Had a Little Lamb*: "I can help Mom every day, every day, every day. I can help Mom every day. God, please show me how."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Let your child see that you are reading from the Bible as you paraphrase down to a few simple sentences. John 2:1-11

LEARN BY DOING:

Think of simple things your little one can do around the house to help you. It makes them feel like an important part of your family and gives you needed help. Keep the jobs simple, such as: get on their shoes and socks, feed the pets, make baby laugh by making faces, bring you items, put napkins on the table, pick up toys (be specific and name one toy at a time). Remember to tell your little ones that you appreciate their help.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- Jesus helped his mother by changing water into wine.
- This was Jesus' first miracle.
- We can help our mother or a special person in our life.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult

Dear God,
We love you.
Thank you for Jesus.
Thank you for my mommy.
Please show me how to help her.
Thank you, thank you, thank you.
In Jesus' name.
