Take Care of Others

Take Home Point:

Jesus takes care of us.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- *Puppet:* Judy wants to help others with a bandage.
- *Bible:* We heard the story Jesus told about the Good Samaritan and then acted it out.
- *Snack:* We ate crackers that looked like a bandage.
- *Craft:* We made a giant bandage to remind us to help others.
- *Game:* We took turns being the Good Samaritan and the hurt man.
- *Singing:* To the tune of *Farmer in the Dell*: "Jesus takes care of us. Jesus takes care of us. He loves all our neighbors. Jesus takes care of us."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. Luke 10:29-37

LEARN BY DOING:

Jesus told the story of the Good Samaritan to illustrate how to love your neighbor as yourself. All people are our neighbors. Do not say mean or cruel things about others in front of your children. Children believe everything their parents say, but they don't have the skills to question the validity of their statements. Be good role models to your children and they will be good to others.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- Jesus takes care of us because he loves us.
- We can show our love to neighbors by helping them.
- Everyone is our neighbor.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult

You love us.
You take care of us.
Thank you, thank you, thank you.
In Jesus' name.
