This Week's Lesson:

Zacchaeus Wants to See Jesus

Take Home Point:

Jesus loves everyone.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- *Puppet:* Judy learns that Jesus loves everyone.
- *Bible:* We listened to and acted out Zacchaeus trying to see Jesus.
- *Snack:* We ate fruit from a tree.
- *Craft:* We made Zacchaeus climb a tree in our craft.
- *Game:* We played a game called *Short or Tall?*
- *Singing:* To the tune of *Mary Had a Little Lamb*: "Jesus loves us everyone, everyone, everyone. Jesus loves us everyone, short or tall or small."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. Luke 19:1-10

LEARN BY DOING:

Make sure your child knows that Jesus loves us no matter what we have done. It makes him sad when we disobey or do wrong things, but he still loves us. He loves people that we do not like; he loves people who do bad things—he loves everyone. Have your child think up traits that would make Jesus sad, and then repeat, "Jesus loves everyone."

TALK ABOUT IT:

- Zacchaeus was too short to see Jesus.
- Zacchaeus figured out a way to see Jesus.
- Jesus loves everyone—no matter what they have done.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult

Dear God,
We love you.
We are so happy.
Jesus loves everyone.
Thank you, thank you, thank you.
In Jesus' name.
